

Curriculum Vitae of Domhnall Cullinan

Domhnall Cullinan is Director of Insurance Supervision at the Central Bank of Ireland (the Central Bank).

Domhnall started his career in 1992 in the Life and Pensions industry. In September 2001 he joined the Pensions Authority, the Irish pensions supervisor. He joined the Central Bank in 2003 and worked in various roles in insurance supervision before being appointed as Head of General Insurance Supervision in June 2012. In June 2014, Domhnall was appointed as Head of the Central Bank's Anti-Money Laundering Division. Domhnall became Director of Insurance Supervision on 1 September 2019.

In addition to supervision, Domhnall has been involved in the development of policy and legislation and has represented the Central Bank at EIOPA, the EBA and the Financial Action Task Force.

Domhnall holds an MBS in Business Practice from the Irish Management Institute/University College Cork.
