Johan Lundström

Johan Lundström joined Insurance Sweden as Head of Legal Affairs in 2007. Insurance Sweden is the business association for life and non-life insurance companies as well as IORPs in Sweden. Johan's main tasks and responsibilities at the association relate to legal policy for insurance and IORP business. He is Insurance Sweden's board of directors secretary. Travelling to Brussels to represent Sweden's insurance and IORP industry is an important part of his work.

Other current assignments include membership of the Ethics Committee of the Swedish Anti-Corruption Institute and Johan is also a member of the board of The Swedish Insurance Society.

From 1996 to 2007 Johan worked at the Ministry of Finance in Stockholm, where his main tasks and responsibilities were insurance business law, including occupational pensions, and the national premium pension system. For the last five years at the ministry he was Deputy Director-General and Head of the Insurance Division, responsible for insurance business law, including insurance mediation and occupational pensions, and the regulation of the national premium pension. Johan's years at the Ministry of Finance included a lot of travelling to Brussels representing Sweden in negotiations in the Council as well as in other work streams related to insurance and occupational pensions.

After law school Johan started his career in 1990 as a court clerk, and then assistant judge and associate judge of appeal in different courts in the Stockholm region.

Johan has a degree of Master of Laws (LLM), from the University of Lund, Lund, Sweden.
