Janina Petelczyc

Janina Petelczyc is an assistant professor in the Department of Social Insurance at the Warsaw School of Economics. Her PhD thesis examined acquisition and preservation of occupational pension rights within the European Union.

Previously, she worked at the University of Warsaw, carried out joint projects in collaboration with the University of Liverpool, and participated in the Horizon 2020 and PR7 EU research projects.

Janina has extensive knowledge of legislation on occupational pension schemes across the EU and on how they work in practice. In her research, she focuses mostly on the structure of supplementary pensions, accessibility of retirement schemes and pension funds' investments.

She provided expert input to various EU councils and groups, including networks of independent experts in the field of intra-EU professional mobility, e.g. for trESS (Training and Reporting on European Social Security) and FreSsco (Free movement of workers and Social security coordination).

Janina regularly publishes in national and international peer-reviewed journals on social security, and especially on retirement insurance.

In addition to her mother tongue (Polish), Janina speaks French, English and Portuguese.
