The IRSG supports the objective of the review of the Guidelines on the supervisory review process (SRP) to align them with the revised Solvency II Directive, a revised Delegated Act and the other revised legal acts (legal framework after the Solvency II review). In addition, the IRSG supports the objective to reduce regulatory burden, particularly for insurance undertakings and groups. While acknowledging that the guidelines are primarily relevant for supervisory authorities we would therefore like to emphasise that the revised guidelines for them should not pose additional burden on insurance undertakings and groups.
