She has a vast experience in the management of international projects such as the EU funded capacity building projects. As a Fellow of the Robert Bosch Foundation Programme for the Young Executives from the Public Sector, Aleksandra worked at the Division for World Bank International Monetary Fund, Debt Issues and International Finance Structure at the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development.

Aleksandra provided expert input to various EU Council's Working Parties such as the Working Party on Financial Services and the Working Party on Competitiveness and Growth; as well as the European Commission's Advisory Committees. Currently she is a member of Financial Services User Group (FSUG) advising the EC's DG Fisma and DG JUST in the preparation of legislation and policy initiatives affecting users of financial services.
