MEETING CONCLUSIONS

AGENDA ITEM 1: APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA

1. The IRSG Chairperson welcomed the attendees to the meeting, particularly two new IRSG members who are replacing members who left the group recently.
2. The IRSG Chairperson presented the meeting agenda and the topics for discussion during the meeting.

CONCLUSIONS AND ACTION POINTS

3. The draft meeting agenda (Eiopa-IRSG-26/09) was approved.

AGENDA ITEM 2: UPDATE BY IRSG CHAIRPERSON

4. The IRSG Chairperson and members informed the group about ongoing work, as well as upcoming deadlines and deliverables, including planned Eiopa consultations to which the IRSG will provide input.

CONCLUSIONS AND ACTION POINTS

5. Members agreed on the proposed work and the next steps.
6. Members are encouraged to indicate their interest in contributing to specific consultations.
7. Members will consider whether work on the proportionality of the RIS regime should be taken up in the coming months. Together with Eiopa, they will assess whether examining proportionate IRRD implementation would be warranted, and what the focus and timing could be to maximise benefits.

AGENDA ITEM 3: UPDATE BY EIOPA

8. The Eiopa Chairperson welcomed IRSG members and thanked them for their valuable input.
9. The Eiopa Chairperson welcomed Eiopa's new Executive Director who stressed that he is looking forward to cooperating with the IRSG.
10. The Eiopa Chairperson updated members on relevant Eiopa activities.

11. The EIOPA Chairperson announced that, following in view of the expiration of the IRSG Chair, Vice Chairs mandate after their two-year-term, an election of a new IRSG Chair and Vice Chairs will be held at the in-person meeting in September.

CONCLUSIONS AND ACTION POINTS

12. IRSG members welcomed the update.

AGENDA ITEM 4: IRSG WORKING GROUP LEADERS UPDATE ON ONGOING CONSULTATION WORK

13. IRSG Working Group Leaders updated members on ongoing and upcoming consultation work, including on insurance guarantee schemes (IGS), the prudential treatment under Solvency II of adaptation measures in NatCat insurance, Solvency II reporting requirements, the authorisation and on-going supervision of (re-)insurance undertakings related to Private Equity, integrated data collection, proportional reinsurance and consumer trends.

CONCLUSIONS AND ACTION POINTS

14. IRSG Members welcomed the update.

AGENDA ITEM 5: IRSG OWN-INITIATIVE WORK ON DIGITILISATION

15. IRSG member María Luisa Muñoz Paredes, leader of the workstream, presented the group's own-initiative report on the impact of digitalisation on risk mutualization.

CONCLUSIONS AND ACTION POINTS

16. IRSG Members welcomed the report, acknowledging the difficulty in reaching joint conclusions, given the diverse views among members.

AGENDA ITEM 6: GEOPOLITICAL RISKS AND INSURABILITY

17. IRSG Member Benoit Waltregny delivered a presentation on geopolitical risks and insurability.
18. EIOPA experts presented their findings on the topic, with a focus on market developments and the consumer perspective.

CONCLUSIONS AND ACTION POINTS

19. IRSG member welcomed the presentations, considering them highly timely.
20. The EIOPA Chairperson stressed that further work in this area needs to be done, in particular on the potential implications for consumers.

AGENDA ITEM 7: THEMATIC REVIEW – UPDATE

21. EIOPA staff informed the group on the progress regarding its Thematic Review on the fair treatment of consumers with chronic illnesses.

CONCLUSIONS AND ACTION POINTS

22. IRSG members exchanged views on EIOPA's initial insights.

23. IRSG members are invited to give further feedback on EIOPA's findings and to share their considerations and market experiences on the topic.

AGENDA ITEM 8: REVIEW OF INSURANCE KPIS UNDER THE TAXONOMY DISCLOSURES DELEGATED ACT

24. EIOPA staff presented its draft Consultation Paper on the review of the Disclosure Delegated Act under the Taxonomy Regulation, including different options to improve existing rules.

CONCLUSIONS AND ACTION POINTS

25. IRSG members gave some initial reactions on EIOPA's considerations.

26. EIOPA will appreciate early IRSG feedback and subsequent participation in the public consultation, scheduled to be published from July until mid-August 2026.

AGENDA ITEM 9: NATCAT PERILS COMMON COVERAGE FRAMEWORK

27. EIOPA staff laid out first considerations on how to promote greater uniformity and consistency of NatCat events' coverage.

CONCLUSIONS AND ACTION POINTS

28. IRSG members engaged in a discussion on the topic.

29. EIOPA looks forward to the IRSG response to a consultation to be planned for launch in December 2026.
