TRAVELLING TO EIOPA





From Frankfurt International Airport



From Frankfurt Central Station



By public transport

By taxi / Uber

At the airport, take the **S8** or **S9** trains towards direction 'Hanau' to go to Frankfurt Central Station ('Hauptbahnhof', 3rd stop).

The journey takes approximately 11 minutes and costs 5.80 EUR for a single ticket and 11.30 EUR for a return ticket (day ticket).

The journey takes 15-20 minutes in light traffic. During rush hour and heavy traffic, the ride may take up to 40 minutes.

Taxis are available at every exit of the airport and will cost 25-30 FUR to Westhafen Tower.

The rates for using an Uber ride are usually similar to taxi fares.

ARRIVAL & REGISTRATION

Upon your arrival, the concierge team of Westhafen Tower will welcome you on the ground floor. Please announce that you are visiting EIOPA and proceed directly to the EIOPA reception desk on the 28th floor, irrespective of your final meeting location.

A valid identity document (passport or ID card with a picture) will be needed for registration purposes.

A limited number of **parking spaces** are available for visitors arriving by car. If you would like to reserve one of the spaces, please send an email with your vehicle licence number to reception@eiopa.europa.eu at least one working day in advance.

Connect private IT devices (e.g. USB drives) to EIOPA systems without authorisation.


Leave personal belongings and confidential documents unattended.

SAFETY & SECURITY



In case of an emergency on your floor

- You will hear a very loud evacuation announcement.
- You are obliged to leave the building immediately, using the stairs.
- Persons with reduced mobility will be directed to the logistics elevators for evacuation by the fire brigade.
- Upon exiting the building, directly go to the assembly point indicated below.

In case of an emergency on another floor / false alarm:

- There will be no loud evacuation announcement, but windows start beeping and close, elevators may not function.
- Announcements may be heard in the staircases or on other floors.
- In such situation there is no need to evacuate unless announced otherwise.



First aid kits are available at the EIOPA reception and in the staff lounges on each floor.



Smoking is not allowed at EIOPA and inside of the building.
