Mireille Aubry began her career as Head of Studies in a French Pensions Institution (CARAC) in 1988. She then worked in the Paris office of Tillinghast-Towers Perrin as a Life Actuarial Consultant from 1992 to 2000 in the fields of product design, profit-testing, embedded values (EV), asset and liability management, mergers and acquisitions and due diligence.

In 2000, she joined the French branch of Winterthur Life and Pensions to take over responsibility for the Life Actuarial Department and produce reporting to the Swiss parent company under French GAAP, US GAAP and EV until the sale of the French activities to MMA in 2002 when she took over the Life Actuarial Department.

Since 2009, she has been responsible for Prudential Regulation Standards & Foresight for COVEA.

Mireille Aubry has been participating in numerous industry and regulators working groups at French and European level.

Mireille Aubry co-chairs AMICE's Prudential Standards Working Group. She is also Vice-Chair of FFA's Solvency 2 Committee and a member of its Risk Management Committee.
