Ms. Renata Gecan Milek is the Head of the Insurance, Leasing and Factoring Supervision Division at the Croatian Financial Services Supervisory Agency (HANFA), whose supervisory scope covers key non-bank financial sectors, including insurance undertakings, leasing and factoring companies, as well as pension and investment fund management companies.

Prior to joining HANFA in 2025, Ms. Gecan Milek served as President of the Management Board of the Croatian Pension Insurance Company, where she led the establishment of the company, securing regulatory approvals, risk management frameworks and investment governance, and building a specialised professional team. Earlier in her career, she worked with the Croatian Pension Insurance Institute (HZMO) on the development of the strategic and operational foundations for a new pension insurance company. She previously held several senior executive roles within the Raiffeisen Group in Croatia, including Director of Private Banking at Raiffeisenbank Austria, President and Board Member of Raiffeisen Invest, and Deputy Director of the Treasury Division, where she oversaw investment processes, treasury operations and business transformation initiatives.

Ms. Gecan Milek holds an MBA in Finance from WU Executive Academy in Vienna and a degree in Economics (Finance major) from the University of Zagreb. She is licensed for managing pension funds and pension insurance companies and holds additional certifications as an investment advisor.
