Jan Matoušek is currently the Executive Director of the Czech Insurance Association, a position he has held since 2015. In this role, he is responsible for the formulation of common industry positions, monitoring market development, enhancing consumer protection through industry self-regulation, ensuring financial education within the insurance sector and enhancing insurance literacy. He also leads the Association's engagement with EU and national lawmakers and stakeholders.

Earlier in his career, he served as Deputy Director of the Czech Banking Association (2008–2015), focusing on stakeholder relations, parliamentary engagement, and the development of European financial regulation. He also held various roles in public administration and diplomacy, including Director of the Cabinet of the Minister of Industry and Trade and Economic diplomat at the Czech Republic's Embassy in Italy.



Jan is a long-standing member of the Government's Regulatory Impact Assessment Commission, where he specializes in financial sector regulation. He also chairs the Board of the Insurance Ombudsman Office, an ADR body for non-life insurance disputes. He represents the Czech insurance industry on the Executive Committee of Insurance Europe.
