Extraordinary EDA calculations

Due to COVID-19 outbreak, as of 24 March 2020, EIOPA carries out extraordinary calculations to monitor the evolution of the symmetric adjustment to equity risk (ED) and to support insurance and reinsurance undertakings in the monitoring of their solvency and financial position.
