

## Curriculum Vitae (Gorazd Čibej)

Gorazd Čibej, LL.M, has been Managing Director of the Insurance Supervision Agency since January 2018.

In 2000 he graduated *cum laude* from the Faculty of Law, University of Ljubljana. He holds a Master's Degree in European Law (LL.M) from Lund University, Sweden, which he obtained in 2001. As a graduated lawyer, he completed his practical training at the Higher Court of Ljubljana. He passed the state bar exam. Afterwards, he was employed by the Ministry of the Environment and Spatial Planning, first in the Environment Directorate and later in the Minister's Office. In 2007 and 2008, he was outsourced as an expert working for the Ministry of the Environment and Spatial Planning in a high-profile team during Slovenia's presidency of the European Union.

Gorazd Čibej was employed by the Insurance Supervision Agency in 2006 to perform a series of complex legal tasks. This included supervision of the insurance market, issuing supervisory measures, management of, and cooperation in the most challenging project teams, conducting infringement procedures, implementation of inspections of operations and preparation of legal advice. In 2015 the National Assembly of the Republic of Slovenia appointed him member of the Council of Experts of the Insurance Supervision Agency for a six-year term of office. Since November 2017, he has also been the President of the Council of Experts of the Insurance Supervision Agency.

As Managing Director, he is also a member of Board of Supervisors of the European Insurance and Occupational Pensions Authority (EIOPA). Within EIOPA, he also served as a member of the Supervisory Steering Committee and a substitute member of the Mediation Panel. Since 2019 he has been a member of the Executive Committee of the International Association of Insurance Supervisors (IAIS) and regional coordinator for the CEET region. Since 2019 he has been a member of the Council of Securities Market Agency of Slovenia.

Since 2000 he has actively participated in seminars and training courses in the areas of mediation, management, political and economic sciences. In 2009 he passed the exam for mediator and was appointed mentor in Alternative Dispute Resolution in 2010. He continued to study negotiation and mediation at the Central European University, where he was awarded the degree of a mediator under the auspices of the Cardozo School of Law, which is recognised by the US Bar Association. In 2016 he completed the certified international business negotiation programme at the Mitchell Hamline University, USA and the following year he participated in advanced training in the field of corporate governance at the Harvard University, USA.
