

Margarida Lima Rego

Margarida Lima Rego is a (tenured) Associate Professor and Vice-Dean at [NOVA School of Law](#), NOVA University, Lisbon, where she has lectured regularly since 2005. She is scientific coordinator of the Master's in Law and Financial Markets, where she teaches Insurance Law, and of the School of Law's PhD Programme in Law. She also coordinates the NOVA Knowledge Centre for Data-Driven Law. As an academic, she has taught different courses and published in a wide range of topics within private law, with a special focus on the law of contract and, most prominently, the insurance contract. Previously, she was of counsel to *Morais Leitão*, where she headed the insurance, reinsurance and pension funds cross-practice team, having left the firm in July 2019 to pursue her academic career on a full-time basis. As an attorney, she provided regular legal counselling in the setting up of varied operations on behalf of domestic and international clients, and in the drafting and negotiation of commercial contracts, with an emphasis on insurance. She is still an active legal consultant who is regularly sought on varied subject matters of Portuguese and Lusophone law, having contributed to dispute resolutions before the courts of several jurisdictions in Europe, Africa, North and South America. Margarida Lima Rego holds a PhD in Private Law with a thesis on third party rights in insurance (NOVA University, Lisbon, 2009), an MPhil in Contract Law (Oxford University, 2001) and an MJur in European and Comparative Law (Oxford University, 2000). She completed her bachelor's degree in Law at Lisbon University (1999). Margarida Lima Rego is an active member of AIDA, the International Insurance Law Association, being president of AIDA Portugal, a member of the Executive and Scientific Committees of AIDA Europe and of the Presidential Council of AIDA World. She is chairwoman of the Commercial Law and Practice Commission of the Portuguese chapter of the International Chamber of Commerce.
