As the Chair Professor of Reinsurance and Risk Management at Cologne University of Applied Sciences, I have gathered a solid academic experience and theory. Together with my previous professional career in the Reinsurance Industry for 14 years I offer a comprehensive view on, and vast experience of (re-) insurance aspects from various perspectives.

My motivation to serve for a second period as a member of the EIOPA IRSG includes:

- being instrumental in an appropriate and continuous development of the regulatory regime of Solvency II,
- supporting the proper amalgamation of theoretical concepts with practical necessities of (re-) insurance regulation,
- adding an independent view on the effects and needs for ongoing improvement of EIOPA's regulation (to balance any lobbying influence).

Since 1998 Prof. Stefan Materne (FCII) has held the Chair of Reinsurance and Risk Management at the Institute of Insurance Studies at the Cologne University of Applied Sciences, Germany. He is also Director of the Research Centre for Reinsurance. Prof. Materne's research focusses on the efficiency of reinsurance, corporate insurance and the Alternative Risk Transfer (ART) with the aspects of Alternative Capital, Insurance Linked Securities and Finite Risk Reinsurance, as well as the regulatory framework and the risk management of (re-) insurance companies and captives. Since 2004, Prof. Materne has also hosted the annual Cologne Reinsurance Symposium, with approx. 530 attendees in 2018.

From 1991 to 2004, Prof. Stefan Materne had worked with the Cologne Re / General Re in various management positions in Germany and abroad.

Prof. Materne has been appointed board member of international (re-) insurance companies and captives as well as academic and regulatory institutions. As arbitrator and expert witness he has served in arbitrations.
