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Travelling to EIOPA

The European Insurance and Occupational Pensions Authority (EIOPA) is based at “Westhafen Tower” (Westhafenplatz 1, 60327 Frankfurt am Main), a 28-floor skyscraper located close to Frankfurt Central Station.

From Frankfurt International Airport

By public transport: Regional train S8 or S9 in the direction of “Hanau” or “Offenbach” go to Frankfurt Central Station (“Hauptbahnhof”, 3rd stop). The journey takes approximately 11 minutes and costs € 5.80 for a single ticket and € 11.30 for a day return ticket.

To buy a ticket at the ticket machines at the airport:

- o For a single ticket *from the airport to Frankfurt* press the button “Frankfurt Einzelfahrt” on the touch screen.
- o For a single ticket *from Frankfurt to the airport* press the button “Frankfurt Flughafen Einzelfahrt” on the touch screen.

Please note the tickets have to be purchased before boarding.

By taxi: Taxis are available at every exit of the airport and cost approximately € 30 EUR to Westhafen Tower. The journey takes 15-20 minutes.

By Uber: The rates for using an Uber ride are usually similar to taxi fares.

Arrival and visitor registration

Arrival at Westhafen Tower

Upon entry, the Front Office team will welcome you at the ground level. Please announce you are visiting EIOPA and proceed directly to the 28th floor, irrespective of your final meeting location.

A valid identity document (passport or ID card with a picture) will be needed for registration purposes.

Hotels

Hotels charge tourists a levy for each night spent in Frankfurt. **Business travellers do not have to pay the tourism tax** as long as they enter the name and address of their employer in the hotel's registration form, confirming that their stay is of a business nature.

Discount rates may be available for our partner hotels in the vicinity of EIOPA, as listed in the table below. Please be aware that hotel rates in Frankfurt can vary strongly during fair and exhibition periods and that discounts may not always apply.

Privacy statement related to the physical access control for visitors

Introduction

1. EIOPA, as a European Authority, is committed to protect individuals with regard to the processing of their personal data in accordance with Regulation (EU) No 2018/1725 (further referred as the Regulation).¹

Controller of the data processing

2. The controller responsible for processing your data is EIOPA's Executive Director.

Purpose of processing your personal data

5. EIOPA collects certain personal information of individual visitors and visitor groups for: a) security purposes, to control access to EIOPA's premises/car park and to ensure the safety of its personnel and guests; and b) statistical purposes, to collect anonymised data on visitors numbers, participation rates in different types of meetings/events, representation rates of different organisations/entities, country representation, and aggregated and average travel distances.
6. Your data will not be used for any purposes other than the performance of the activities specified above. Otherwise you will be informed accordingly.

Legal basis and lawfulness of processing

7. EIOPA Security Policy (EIOPA/POL/LSO/35) complemented by Commission Decision 2001/844/EC, ECSC, Euratom of 29 November 2001 amending its internal Rules of Procedure.

In accordance with Article 5(a) Regulation 2018/1725:

Processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest on the basis of the EU treaties – namely physical protection of EIOPA staff, information and assets, safety conditions (including evacuation and emergency situations), visitors and access control to EIOPA premises.

Personal data collected

8. The data collected is restricted to visitor identification data, i.e. the ones appearing in identification documents including names of the data subjects, name of the employer or institution/entity represented (if applicable), vehicle licence plate numbers (if applicable), origin of travel route to EIOPA (if applicable), and general information concerning the visit, such as the name of the meeting/event, the name of the EIOPA staff visited, the expected date and time of arrival and departure.

Recipients of your personal data

9. Access to the data collected is restricted to staff assigned to EIOPA's Corporate Services Team (which includes facility managers, meeting assistants, and event coordinators), EIOPA's Security Officer, as well as selected consierge and security personnel of the Westhafen Tower operator MANN Management GmbH and personnel of EIOPA's reception services provider.
10. No personal data is transferred to parties other than those listed above.

Transfer of personal data to a third country or international organisation

11. No personal data is transferred to a third country or international organisation.

Retention period

12. Personal data will be retained up to three month by EIOPA's reception, at which point any attributable information, such as names and vehicle licence plate numbers which would allow the identification of individual persons, will be deleted. Only aggregated data on total visitor numbers, participation rates in different types of meetings/events, representation rates of different organisations/entities, country representation, travel distances, and similar will be retained for statistical purposes.
13. Any visitor records provided to the consierge and security service of the Westhafen Tower operator MANN Management GmbH will be destroyed one working day after the day of visit.

Profiling

14. No profiling or automated processing of personal data is taking place.

Your rights

15. You have the right to access your personal data, receive a copy of them in a structured and machine-readable format or have them directly transmitted to another controller, as well as request their rectification or update in case they are not accurate.
16. For security reasons, please note that your right to request the erasure of your personal data, as well as your right to object to or obtain the restriction of their processing will be restricted, in accordance to EIOPA's Management Board decision adopting internal rules concerning restrictions of certain rights of data subjects (EIOPA-19-056).
17. Should you wish to access/delete your personal data, or receive a copy of them/have it transmitted to another controllertheir processing, please contact the EIOPA reception (reception@eiopa.europa.eu).

For the protection of your privacy and security, every reasonable step shall be taken to ensure that your identity is verified before granting access.

18. Any complaint concerning the processing of your personal data can be addressed to EIOPA's Data Protection Officer (DPO@eiopa.europa.eu). Alternatively you can also have at any time recourse to the **European Data Protection Supervisor** (www.edps.europa.eu).
